

Information for Teachers

This book has four stories to consolidate the phonics and high-frequency words introduced in our earlier books. The stories are written in the present tense.

The vocabulary reinforces the vowel digraphs and trigraphs 'ay, ai, ee, ea, ie, ou, ow, oo, oo, er, ar, or, ear'.

The vowel digraph 'oy' is introduced in the word 'toy'.

The letter combination 'all' is used in the words 'all, small, ball, wall, falls'.

Some of the 'tricky' words included are 'so, there, where, one, come, some, they, want, water, mother, move'.
