

## Information for Teachers

This book has three more stories about Follifoot Farm and the animals who live there. Children can read for themselves about how an open farm gate leads to trouble and what happens when there is too much rain. They can see how the lives of all the animals on the farm are interconnected.

The stories are written in the present tense. There are no new phonics in this book.

The vowel digraphs 'ai, ay, a-e, ee, ea, ie, ar, er, oo, oo, oi, or, ou, ow' are used as well as the trigraph 'ear'.

The new 'tricky' high-frequency words are 'their, what'.
