

Information for Teachers

The sentences in this book are made up of many CVC words which have rhyming endings. The aim of the book is to give children reinforcement for their early word learning, so that they have the confidence to move on to read words with more complicated spellings.

The vowel digraphs used in the stories are: *ee, ea, ay, or, oo, ou.*

It is assumed that children are familiar with the high-frequency words *the, I, go, to, into, oh, no, he, she, are, have, going, you.*

The new 'tricky' words that children will meet in the stories are:
all, call, fall, can't, they, her, he's, goes, so, come.
