

Information for Teachers

This book is for children to read independently when they are able to read some words containing consonant digraphs and vowel digraphs..

The consonant digraphs used in the stories are **ng, ck, th, sh, ch.**

The vowel digraphs used in the stories have all been introduced in our set of *Vowel Sounds* books. These are **ee, ai, oo, or, ay, er.**

There are two lines of text on each page. The stories are written in the present tense.

The high-frequency 'tricky' words used in the stories are **the, no, to, go, oh, he, we, she, by, are, going, her, they, all.**

* The consonant trigraph 'dge' is used in the word 'hedgehog'
