

## Information for Teachers

This book contains stories for children to read independently when the vocabulary contains common pronouns and some words with vowel digraphs.

Speech and speechmarks are included in the sentences.

There are two lines of text on each page.

The vowel digraphs **ee, ay, ou, ow, oo, oo, ar, er, or, ou** are used.

Words with consonants to blend at their beginning or end are used throughout.

The new 'tricky' words used are **he, you, she, me, we, her, have, comes, oh, no, are, they, water.**
