

Information for Teachers

This book is for children learning to read when the vocabulary in the story contains words with vowel digraphs.

Each vowel digraph is introduced in the context of the story. One new digraph is introduced in each story.

The vowel digraphs introduced in this book are **er, ar, or, oo**.

The consonant digraphs used in this book are **th, ch**.

The high-frequency tricky words are **the, to, go, no, oh, he, into, onto**.

<i>The Otter</i>	er, ee	otter river
<i>Bark, Bark</i>	ar, oo	Bart barks stars dark park yard smart barn
<i>A Sack of Corn</i>	or, ee	corn torn horse snorts floor door
<i>The Brook</i>	oo, or, ee	brook looks foot good wood

*A digraph is two letters representing one sound.
